



Elections will be held at the next Intergroup Delegates' Meeting on April 27th. Please encourage all Group Delegates to come and vote!!

Just a few reminders:

- Only Intergroup Delegates or their Alternates are eligible to vote. This ensures only one vote per group.
- It is recommended that those elected have a minimum of 2 years sobriety, be a past or present Intergroup Delegate or Alternate with at least 6 months of service and belong to a group not currently represented on the Steering Committee.
- Nominating yourself for a position can be done by submitting it in writing up until 5:00pm of the day of elections. You may
 mail them directly to the Intergroup Office.
- Those nominated must be present at the elections in order to accept the position if elected or have submitted their acceptance in writing.
- All positions carry a 1 year term, with Vice Chair rotating to Chair the following year, Assistant Treasurer rotating to Treasurer the following year and Chairperson rotating to Trustee the following year.
- All Committee Chair positions will be available as of June. If anyone is interested in filling one of these positions, please contact the Steering Committee by the May 25th meeting.
